The Pioneer Chapter participated in a Safety Fair at the Wal Mart store in Woodburn, Oregon on October 15th. David Scott and Larry Arendt were in our informational booth to talk to everyone about SAFETY while hunting and the many activities that the Oregon Hunters Association members are involved in. Also they gave out gun safety locks and literature on wildlife and wildlife habitat.

Also the chapter board members are putting together a scholarship fund. We hope to have this in place to award two scholarships at the annual banquet in 2006. This will help with expenses for two college students.

There has been some discussion about continuing to service water guzzlers in Central Oregon. This has been a very worthwhile project in maintaining a water supply for wildlife in the desert. We have maintained ten water guzzlers in the Millican area for eight years. This includes hauling water sometimes when it doesn't rain enough to keep the reservoirs full, also maintaining birdhouses and keeping the fences in repair around the water guzzlers. After a lot of discussion at the chapter board meeting, the board voted to continue to service the water guzzlers.
