Presidents Message

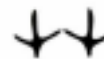
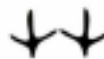

10th ANNUAL BANQUET

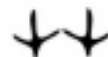
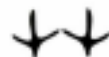
A big thank you goes out to everyone who attended the 2006 OHA Pioneer chapter banquet and to those who made donations, with out you there would be no banquet.

USFS REVIEWING ATV TRAVEL OHA Members Encouraged to Offer Local Testimony

Local districts of the U.S. Forest Service throughout Oregon will be reviewing what roads and trails should remain open to all-terrain vehicles, as part of a nationwide review of travel management on our National Forests.

The Oregon Hunters Association State Board of Directors encourages its members to participate in

the process, because there will be opportunity to influence the regulations on a local level.

OHA recognizes an important balance between providing reasonable access and also preserving safe haven for wildlife and quality hunting experiences, and hopes members will offer their own insights with those objectives in mind.
