#### Presidents Message

The end of a hot dry summer and almost statewide deer season. Also sight-in-days are almost over for another year. If you missed the September Sight-in-days, some of the rifle clubs have an October weekend that will also be open to the public. Be sure to get your rifle sighted in. You wouldn't want to miss that big Buck or Bull.

In July of 2008, the Oregon Hunters Association was alerted to the possibility of a land exchange in eastern Oregon based on a request from Dr. Scott Campbell. At that time OHA sent out an email alert to its members announcing the exchange and urging them to contact Oregon's Congressional Delegation and ask them to stop this exchange. Since that time, a number of meetings have occurred between OHA and Dr. Campbell's representative to discuss the details of the exchange. Through our efforts during this time, the amount of acres requested in the exchange for 1,000 acres on Steens Mountain decreased from more than 10,000 acres in the Silvies Valley to approximately 4,297 acres. During this time, too, no congressional action occurred on the exchange. At its last board meeting in July, the OHA Board of Directors reaffirmed its opposition to the exchange. It is now apparent that some movement is beginning to occur at the congressional level. OHA is currently updating the email alert and will be sending it out shortly if action on the exchange seems likely. We will keep you posted.
