In the December newsletter I wrote about the poachers in Oregon being predators. Poaching ran rampant as fall hunting season waned.

Four Lane County-area men face charges for the unlawful killing of four branch-antlered bull elk on October 20th on private land south of Cottage Grove. The four poached elk were reported to be a 3 point, 5 point, 6 point and a 6x7.

Oregon State Police are encouraging people to report poaching activity, especially now that most rifle deer hunting seasons are ending and many large bucks are illegally killed in the following weeks.

In one case in November, OSP received information about a large 4x4 buck that was shot at a Jackson County golf course. It was unlawfully killed by a man who did not have a deer tag.

ODFW TO LOOK AT HUNTER ORANGE

Recently a fatal hunting accident occurred in Oregon involving a young hunter, who was not wearing blaze orange and was shot by a member of his own hunting party who reportedly mistook him for a cow elk.

After hearing about the details of this incident during the December Oregon Fish and Wildlife Commission meeting, the Commission requested that the department begin review of Oregon's policy regarding the wearing of blaze orange while hunting. The Commission heard from Director Roy Elicker, who stated that in many states hunters are required by law to wear blaze orange because doing so allows them to be easily seen by others and reduces shooting incidents. Elicker continued by stating that ODFW encourages hunters to wear blaze orange but does not require it.

The ODFW Commission will consider the policy during its review and adoption of the 2011 hunting regulations.

OHA policy supports voluntary use of hunter orange in rifle or upland bird hunting, but does not support making it mandatory. A majority of 1,000 OHA members surveyed stated they did not favor a blaze orange requirement for adult hunters.
