The numbers for those who actually report are very poor, according to ODFW. A meeting has been called by ODFW to look at establishing some type of rewards system that gives hunters an incentive to report their results. As part of this process, they will examine what has worked well in other states and what motivates hunters to make their reports.

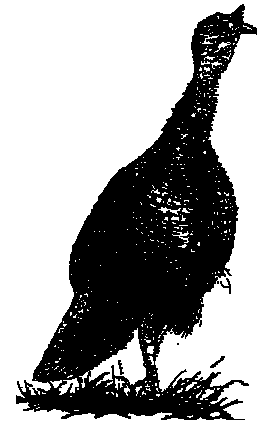
MARCH MONTHLY MEETING
